Scores for John Student:

John was given the Iowa Tests of Basic Skills in April 2018. At the time of testing, he was in seventh grade at Academy in Abeka Testing.

The Composite score can be used to describe a student's overall achievement on the tests. John earned a Composite grade equivalent of 3.7 on the Level 13 test. This means that his test performance was approximately the same as that of a typical student in the third grade at the end of the seventh month. John's Composite national percentile rank of 4 means that he scored higher than 4 percent of seventh grade students nationally. His overall achievement appears to be low for seventh grade.

A student's ability to read is related to success in many areas of schoolwork. John's Reading Comprehension score is well below average when compared with those of other students in seventh grade nationally.

A student's scores can be compared with each other to determine relative strengths and weaknesses. Vocabulary, Reading Comprehension, Spelling, Punctuation, Usage and Expression, Concepts & Estimation, Math Computation, Science, Maps and Diagrams, and Reference Materials seem to be areas of relative strength for John. Some of these strengths might be used to help improve other areas.
