The annual benefits open enrollment period for the following products will be held for two weeks in July for the plan year starting September 1:

- **Health Plan:** While we have enjoyed the same healthcare premium for the last four years, there will be an approximate 5% increase in the premiums on most coverage options.
- **Voluntary Life:** There is no increase in the premiums with The Standard, unless you are in a new age/price bracket.
- **Dental/Vision:** Rates through Sunlife and VSP are still being negotiated, but you should expect a premium increase.
