Benefits Open Enrollment

The annual benefits open enrollment period for the following products will be held for two weeks in July for the plan year starting September 1:

- **Health Plan:** Rates for singles and families are expected to moderately increase based on increasing health costs.
- **Voluntary Life:** Rates for the Standard category are being negotiated and are expected to increase moderately. There will be an increase if you are in a new age/price bracket.
- **Dental/Vision:** Rates through SunLife and VSP are still being negotiated, but you should expect a premium increase. SunLife has been successful in recruiting more local in-network endodontists.
