- 3. Carefully follow the on-screen instructions.




You'll share your mailbox with a couple of other students. Take the mail with your name on it, and leave the rest for your box mates!

Already registered?

Register for Classes

Deadline is Mon., Aug. 25, 12 noon CT.

If you've not yet finalized registration, visit eaglesnest.pcci.edu/Registration to complete the process.

Take placement/proficiency exams (if needed).

Complete registration forms and remove holds.

Click "Register" to sign forms and note any holds. Contact your Admissions Counselor for any Admissions holds. You will need to clear all holds before creating a class schedule.

- Download the Transact eAccounts App on your mobile device.
- Select Pensacola Christian College, and sign in with your PCC Microsoft account credentials.
- Click "Add to Wallet." Your card will be available for use within 10-15 minutes!
