## Set Up Wi-Fi Technology

Setting up your technology is simple!

### Wi-Fi Setup Instructions

Wireless internet access is available in each residence hall, academic buildings, the library, Commons, and Sports Center. Follow these steps to set up access:

1. Connect to the network PCC Wi-Fi Setup.
2. Open your browser and go to [wifi.pcci.edu](http://wifi.pcci.edu).
3. Carefully follow the on-screen instructions.

## Check Your Mailbox


### Commons

You'll share your mailbox with a couple of other students. Take the mail with your name on it, and leave the rest for your box mates!

If you receive mail that's too large for your mailbox, you'll receive an email notification to claim your package from the Commons Post Office. Claim packages by presenting your PCC Card at the counter.

## Register Your Vehicle

### Eagle's Nest

#### Already registered?

Your permits are in your campus mailbox. Follow the instructions on the envelope to apply them as soon as possible.

#### Haven't registered your vehicle or bicycle?

Register it at [eaglesnest.pcci.edu/VehicleRegistration](http://eaglesnest.pcci.edu/VehicleRegistration). Your permits will be placed in your mailbox within 24 hours and must be applied to your vehicle the same day you receive them.

# STEP 5

## Register for Classes

Deadline is Fri., Jan. 16, 12 noon CT.

If you've not yet finalized registration, visit [eaglesnest.pcci.edu/Registration](http://eaglesnest.pcci.edu/Registration) to complete the process.

**Take placement/proficiency exams (if needed).**

**Complete registration forms and remove holds.**

Click "Register" to sign forms and note any holds. Contact your Admissions Counselor for any Admissions holds. You will need to clear all holds before creating a class schedule.

**Create class schedule.**

Review the "Planning Tips" on Eagle's Nest for important info. Then follow the online catalog or your plan of study to find which classes to register for this semester.

**Register for classes.**

Schedule an appointment with your Student Success Advisor to finalize your registration at [eaglesnest.pcci.edu/Advisor](http://eaglesnest.pcci.edu/Advisor).

# STEP 6

## Purchase and Pick Up Textbooks

PCC has partnered with Barnes & Noble College to provide an online bookstore for your course materials. The store offers competitive pricing, up-front guaranteed buyback offers, rental options, and 24/7 customer support.

If you use Barnes & Noble College, choose to ship to campus and select an option that will ensure you receive your books as quickly as possible. You'll receive an email when they're ready to pick up.



Your PCC Card gives you campus access and works as a debit card for campus purchases once you add funds.

**You'll receive a physical ID and can also download it to your mobile device! Here's how.**

- Download the Transact eAccounts App on your mobile device.
- Select Pensacola Christian College, and sign in with your PCC Microsoft account credentials.
- Click "Add to Wallet." Your card will be available for use within 10-15 minutes!

Many card readers display this symbol.  Tap your card or phone against the reader to gain access or pay.

### Transportation

PCC students receive free access to Microsoft 365 during their enrollment and have access to several on-campus computer labs with printers.


### Eagle Express Cleaners
