Dress Guidelines:

General Campus

Clothing should be modest and appropriate for the occasion. Campus Tours—**Men:** casual pants, shorts (longer lengths), and sports shirts. **Women:** dresses, skirts and blouses, knee-length walking shorts and casual shirts; no pants or jeans, please.

Sports Center

Men: casual shirt; athletic pants, jeans, or shorts (longer lengths); jeans or wind/athletic pants required for rock climbing; trunk-style swimsuit for the water park and Swim Center.

Women: casual shirt; knee-length denim/casual skirt or walking shorts; wind/athletic pants required for rock climbing (optional for ice skating); modest swimsuit that fully covers midriff for the water park and Swim Center.

Guest cards are required for admittance to all campus facilities and activities.

Residence Halls: Although guest residence hall stays or visits are not available spring 2021, you may still visit classes and reserve campus tours.
