## How does PCC compare to other colleges and universities?

Four years at PCC gives you the highest quality at the most affordable price. Just compare and see for yourself. The cost for each college includes tuition and fees, room and board, estimated books and supplies, and estimated living expenses, and it subtracts the average grant and scholarship amounts that students receive.



Annual tuition, fees, and room and board are based on the 2018–2019 rates reported on those institutions' websites. Other school's books, supplies, and other living expenses are based on the 2017–2018 National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) reports. Other school's average annual grants and scholarships are based on the 2016–2017 NCES reports.



# SCHOLARSHIPS

## Christian Service \$2,500–\$4,000

For students with parents serving full time in a Bible-believing Christian ministry.

## Ministerial \$2,500–\$4,000

For students who have a declared a Bible major\* intending to be a minister of the gospel.

## Teacher Education \$2,500–\$4,000

For students who have declared an education major.

## Armed Services \$2,500–\$4,000

For students who were honorably discharged from the U.S. armed forces or have a parent who is currently serving or has previously served in the U.S. armed forces.\*

## Academic Honors \$2,000–\$3,200

For students who have a minimum GPA of 3.50 and were either valedictorian or salutatorian of their class or have scored a minimum composite score of 25 on the ACT, 80 on the CLT, or 1220 on the SAT.

## Alumni \$700–\$1,000

For students who have a parent who graduated from PCC in a four-year undergraduate program.

## Abeka Academy Tuition Amount varies

For students who have completed at least a full 12th-grade enrollment through Abeka Academy and have enrolled at PCC within one year of high school graduation.

(May not be combined with *Fourth-Year-Free program*.)

# SCHOLARSHIP INITIAL ELIGIBILITY

- Must declare a four-year major.
- Must be a U.S. or Canadian citizen or U.S. permanent resident.
- Applicants may receive only one scholarship.
- Except where noted, applicants qualifying for scholarships may also apply for the Fourth-Year-Free program and/or work assistance for additional financial aid.
- Apply for scholarships by June 15 (fall applicants) or December 1 (spring applicants).

With a \$500 investment, students can attend their fourth year of college for free.


- Find out more at [pcci.edu/YearFree](https://pcci.edu/YearFree), then send in your Fourth Year Free agreement form accepting the offer. For fall applicants, the deadline is June 15. For spring applicants, the deadline is December 1.
- Standard tuition, room & board must be paid for 6 consecutive semesters. Free tuition, room and board\* will be received in the 7th and 8th semesters.

## Work Assistance

PCC maintains a part-time work assistance program for qualified residence hall students. Many of our students work on campus, earning \$1,775–\$4,440 per year while gaining valuable skills.

- Students may apply to work 8–20 hours per week.
- Work assistance is provided on the basis of financial need and work availability on campus.
- International students, though not eligible for work assistance, may apply for other student employment.

# STEPS TO APPLY TO PCC


1. Look at the application windows below and apply early if you can! Applying early saves you money and gets you an acceptance decision faster.

Application Window	Reservation Deposit	Date
Early Decision	\$100	Mar. 1
Regular Decision	\$125	Mar. 2–June 30
Late Decision	\$150*	July 1–Aug. 20

\* \$125 regular deposit + \$25 late fee

2. Go to [pcci.edu/ApplyNow](https://pcci.edu/ApplyNow) to apply.
3. Submit official transcripts.
4. Complete Recommendation forms.
5. Get your ACT, SAT, or CLT scores sent in. (To do this automatically, just use PCC's ACT number 0707, SAT number 5970, or choose PCC from the list of CLT colleges when you register for the test.)
6. If you want to work on campus, apply for the work assistance program at [pcci.edu/Work](https://pcci.edu/Work).
7. Apply for scholarships at [pcci.edu/Scholarship](https://pcci.edu/Scholarship).
8. Apply for Financial Aid.
