Learn to accurately translate God's Word from the original languages, specifically from the Masoretic Text and Textus Receptus. Your studies will focus on Bible doctrine and on examining the Scriptures in Greek and Hebrew.

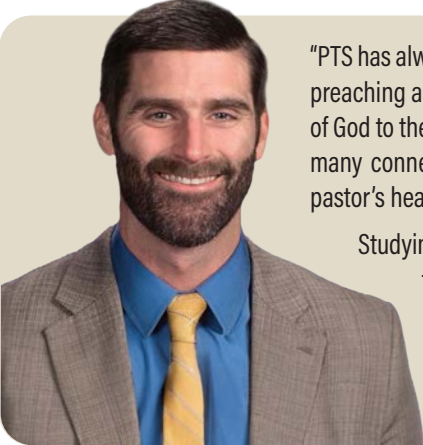

Our courses approach study from a biblicist viewpoint, helping students transform their hearts through direct interaction with God's powerful Word.

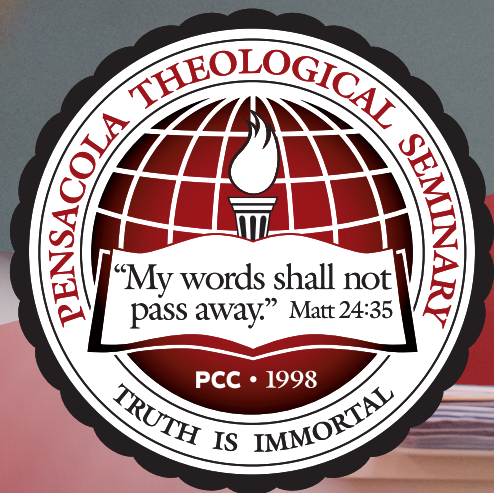
