Students like you have found that they thrive on our campus and then graduate ready to **influence the world for Christ** through their future endeavors.

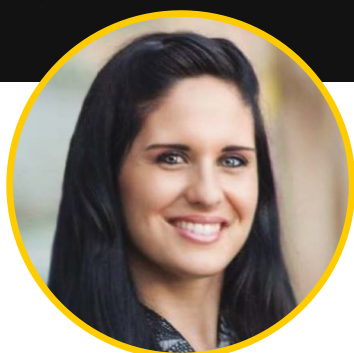
From your circle of friends to the positions you hold, you are a leader. And helping you **become the right kind of leader** is the primary purpose at PCC.

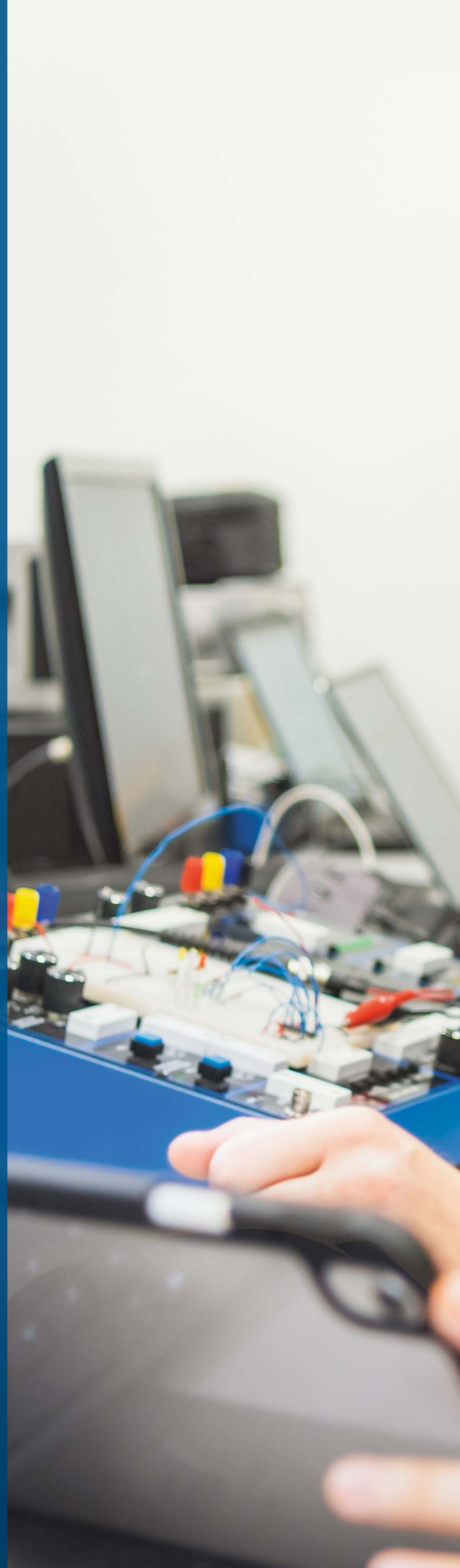

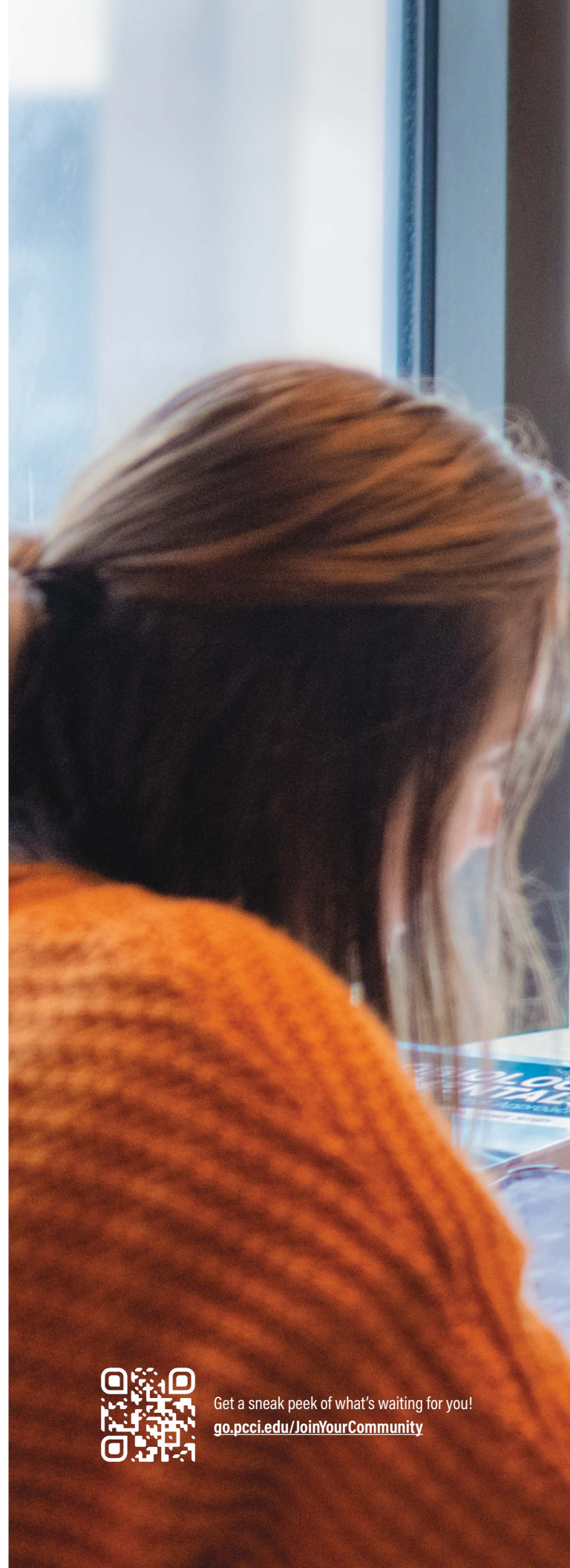
