## Stumped

The word *stumped* communicates the idea that we just simply don't know what to do. The expression came from the days of the frontiersmen: land would need to be cleared and trees felled, after which the stumps would need to be removed. Many frontiersmen prided themselves in their expert ability to remove even the largest stumps from the ground. However, when even an experienced frontiersman would, after great effort, fail to remove the stump of a fallen tree, he would finally exclaim with great frustration that he was stumped.

When the people of Israel found themselves at odds with their enemies and had no means by which they could secure a victory, their first statement, recorded in 2 Chronicles 20:12, was, "Neither know we what to do". To put it plainly, they were stumped. Quite possibly, you have some quandary that has you stumped. You've explored all your options and come repeatedly to the same dead end. You may have even said to others, "I just don't know what to do."

Thankfully, the people of Israel didn't stop with "we don't know what to do," but instead went on to say, "But our eyes are upon thee," as 2 Chronicles 20:12 concludes. Have you ever considered the fact that the impossible situation that has you stumped was actually given to you by God for that very purpose—to stump you? Being stumped places our eyes beyond our strength, our resources, and our abilities.
