A Word from Pastor Jeff Redlin

D ecently, while reading Psalm 119, I noticed a word that was used continually. In $oldsymbol{\Pi}$ fact, it was repeated over 20 times. It is the word *precept*. I felt like I had a decent understanding of the word but wanted to be sure, so I looked in the dictionary. The first dictionary I used was a modern-day dictionary. It defined precept as "a general rule intended to regulate behavior or thought." Unsatisfied that I had a truly accurate definition, I went to the library and found an old dictionary. It was first published in the 1930s. It's huge. There, the word precept is defined in a way that, I believe, is a more accurate reflection of its biblical definition. The old Webster's dictionary says that precept is "an authoritative command; order; mandate." The modern definition conveys the idea of a general suggestion or of an intention that would be nice if it were followed. Not the old Webster. It communicates the idea that this is no mere recommendation: this is a command.

Our lives become a confusing mess when at the Word of God and its principles as we begin to treat God's laws and com- a recommendation?
